

AAA Road Trip Checklist

PREPARING YOUR VEHICLE

Visit your mechanic

- Fulfill any required maintenance
- Get a free vehicle maintenance inspection with AAA Approved Auto Repair (AAA.com/AutoRepair)

Battery

- Look for clean, tight cable connections and check for corrosion
- Secure hold-down hardware
- Ask mechanic to check battery life

Tires

- Look for cuts, gouges or sidewall bulges
- Check tread depth
- Inflate to recommended tire pressure
- Look for same issues on your spare tire

Fluid levels

- Brake
- Coolant
- Oil
- Power steering
- Transmission
- Windshield washer

Belts and hoses

- Check for cracks, damage and corrosion

Windshield wipers

- Check for cracks, tears and brittleness (replace if needed and save at AAA.com/NAPA)

A/C

- Test drive with the air conditioner running

EMERGENCY KITS

For your car

- Car battery booster cables
- Emergency flares, reflectors or battery-powered LED beacons
- Portable tool kit
- Duct tape
- Gloves
- Shop rags or paper towels
- Insurance information



For people

- Alcohol-based hand sanitizer (at least 60% alcohol)
- Face coverings
- EPA-registered disinfectant and other personal cleaning supplies
- First-aid supplies
- Medicine
- Drinking water
- Nonperishable snacks for people and pets
- Flashlight with extra batteries
- Rain poncho
